Dear Parents/Carers,

Earlier this week Boris Johnson announced that schools may start to re-open from the 8th March, if the pressure on the NHS reduces.

We have been told that we will get 2 weeks notice confirming if we are able to open or not.

I know that this is very frustrating for parents who are working incredibly hard to support their children with home learning. Last week we had a superb **94%** of pupils who are at home, attend online lessons. This is a fantastic effort and I would like to thank you all for supporting your children to do this.

As it is at least another 4 weeks of home learning it is vital that children continue to engage with online lessons and ask teachers questions whenever they need to. We are also trying to find ways of allowing pupils to be able to interact with their friends who are in school, at other times of the day in a purely social manner. This will help support our children's wellbeing.

Staff testing

The government have now introduced Lateral Flow Tests for Primary School staff which allows adults working in schools to test themselves twice a week for Covid19. This is purely voluntary and up to individuals to decide if they wish to do this. Across our region, these new tests have resulted in staff testing positive in other schools and subsequently 'bubbles' having to shut and having pupils isolate.

Should we get a positive result for an adult who works in a class then we will need to close that bubble and pupils will need to isolate. Our staff member would then book a PCR test to confirm the result. If that is positive then pupils will need to continue to isolate, if it is negative then the bubble can return to school.

Should a staff member in Woodcroft Primary School test positive and there is a need to close a class bubble then we will inform parents as quickly as possible.


