Thank you to all of you who attended your child's parents' evening this week. If you were unable to make either of those days please speak to the class teacher or the office about arranging an appointment.

Coronavirus

We are currently following all of the guidance that the government has set out in it's plans to tackle the Coronavirus. Teachers are ensuring that all pupils wash their hands regularly and we have provided extra hand sanitiser in class. The current guidance, which may change over the coming days or weeks, is that if your child has a new persistent cough or a fever then they should self-isolate for 7 days. You do not need to phone 111 unless their condition worsens or is still present after 7 days. A child who does not show any symptoms of the virus does not need to be off school even if a family member is self-isolating.

If your child does become ill with these symptoms, please phone school as soon as possible and we will provide you with a return date for your child.

At present, there are no plans to shut the school, but we will continue to follow any advice from the government as it happens. If you have any queries please do not hesitate to contact the school office.

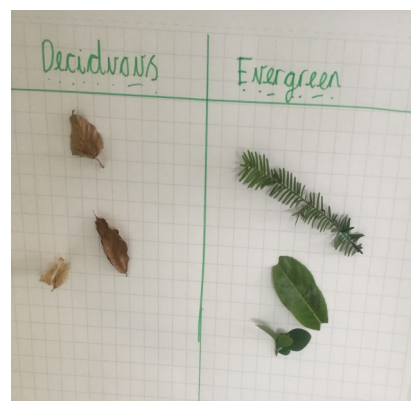
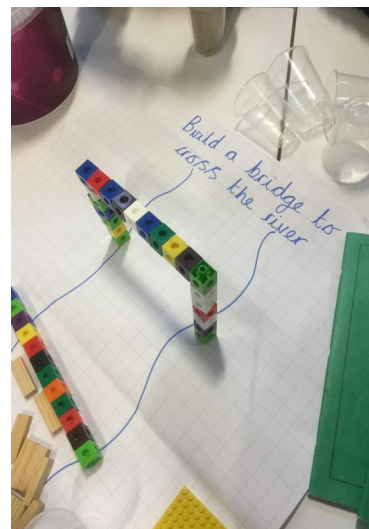
