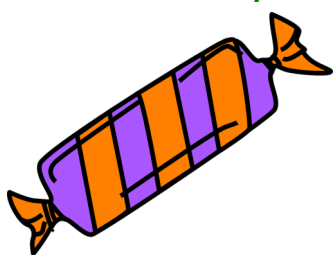
Our attendance target is 97% each week.
